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1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Andro Secure Group is a globally operating, multi-domain security provider delivering integrated protection across maritime, aviation, ground transportation, and executive protection environments. Led by ex-military leadership and underpinned by proprietary autonomous technology, the Group is consistently rated best-in-class by international insurance providers and serves corporate, government, and high-value private clients across five continents.

In today's threat environment, fragmented security arrangements are not merely inefficient — they are dangerous. A guard company for ports, a separate contractor for vessel escorts, and an IT firm for cyber protection creates patchwork coverage with communication gaps and slow response times precisely when speed matters most. The Andro Secure Group was built to solve this problem at its root.

We position maritime, facility, personnel, and digital protection not as a menu of options, but as a unified operational system. Every layer communicates. Every asset is coordinated. Every response is informed by a shared operational picture. When a drone detects a suspicious vessel approaching a client's ship at anchor, that intelligence simultaneously alerts the onboard security team, the port facility command centre, and the cyber operations unit — because a physical threat and a digital intrusion may be two vectors of the same attack.

It is an operational architecture, refined over years of active deployment in high-risk environments across Africa, the Middle East, Europe, and the Americas. The Group’s origins are rooted in the recognition that corporate and governmental enterprises operating in unpredictable environments — facing political unrest, civil instability, natural disasters, terrorism, and increasingly sophisticated organised crime — require security partners capable of functioning as true integrated risk management partners, not reactive service providers.

Andro Secure Group’s management system is anchored in the European Foundation for Quality Management (EFQM) Excellence Model — recognised since 1994 in the United Kingdom and adopted by 52% of all European public sector organisations by 2000, according to PricewaterhouseCoopers. The EFQM framework operates across nine key performance criteria, testing organisations against robust standards across leadership, people development, process management, client focus, and continuous improvement. This is not an aspirational framework; it is the operational backbone of how Andro Secure Group plans, executes, measures, and improves every engagement.

The Group’s directors and managers collectively bring expertise spanning: military operations planning, combat strategies and logistics, supply chain design and optimisation, mechanical and industrial engineering, organisational behaviour, personal and close protection, IT security, high-level business management, and commodity brokering across mining, finance, agriculture, energy, and FMCG sectors.



3. CORE SERVICE LINES

Andro Secure Group delivers integrated protection across four primary operational domains. Unlike providers offering isolated services, every domain connects to a unified command-and-control infrastructure — enabling coordinated response across sea, air, land, and digital environments simultaneously.

3.1 Maritime Protection — Naval Division

The Andro Secure Group Naval Division is a specialised maritime security, protection, and risk management organisation delivering integrated solutions to commercial shipping operators, offshore energy companies, port facilities, government agencies, critical infrastructure operators, and maritime logistics organisations across international maritime environments.

The maritime threat landscape is evolving at pace. From the Gulf of Guinea to the Strait of Malacca and the waters off the Horn of Africa, piracy and armed attacks at sea remain among the most significant operational risks in commercial shipping. Beyond the open ocean, vessels at anchor are vulnerable to theft, sabotage, and unauthorised boarding; port facilities face infiltration risks capable of compromising entire supply chains; and IT systems, navigation networks, and cargo management infrastructure are increasingly targeted by hostile actors with the capability to disable or redirect vessels remotely.

On-Sea Vessel Protection Continuous, layered security for vessels in transit through high-risk corridors. Autonomous drone boats patrol ahead of and alongside protected vessels, creating a visible deterrent perimeter that hostile craft cannot cross without detection. Aerial drones provide over-the-horizon surveillance, identifying approaching threats before they enter engagement range. The Group is also the only transporter operating with freight insurance coverage from point of pick-up to point of delivery — a commitment that reflects total accountability for the assets entrusted to its care.

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3.3 Aviation Security

Protection is discreet, professional, and calibrated to the specific threat profile of each individual and location. Every VIP engagement begins with a comprehensive risk assessment, and passenger liability insurance is integrated into transit services to address the elevated road death risk inherent in high-risk operating environments.

4. TECHNOLOGY DIFFERENTIATORS & PROPRIETARY SYSTEMS

Technology is not a supporting feature of the Andro Secure Group service offering — it is the foundation. The Group's proprietary autonomous drone boats and aerial surveillance systems create a competitive advantage that conventional security providers simply cannot replicate. These are not off-the-shelf products; they are purpose-built assets designed for the specific demands of maritime threat response and deterrence in the world's most challenging operational environments.

Key Differentiator: Andro Secure Group's drone assets are not reactive tools — they are proactive deterrents. The visible presence of autonomous systems fundamentally changes the risk calculus for any potential attacker, often preventing an incident before it begins. A hostile actor who sees drone boats patrolling a vessel's perimeter must reconsider the feasibility of an attack.

Autonomous Drone Boats

Small autonomous drone boats operate as both deterrent and rapid-response asset simultaneously. Deployed ahead of or alongside a protected vessel, they create a physical barrier that hostile craft cannot cross without detection. Equipped with real-time communication, GPS tracking, and onboard sensors, they can intercept, shadow, and delay approaching threats while coordinating with human operators and naval authorities. Their small footprint and high manoeuvrability make them effective in both open water and congested harbour environments.

Aerial Surveillance Drones

The aerial drone fleet extends situational awareness far beyond the visual horizon. Capable of long-range reconnaissance, thermal imaging, and real-time video transmission, these assets provide the early warning that every effective maritime security operation depends upon. A piracy skiff approaching at speed can be identified minutes before it enters visual range — minutes that translate directly into options: evasive manoeuvre, authority notification, deployment of countermeasures, or coordinated interdiction. In harbour environments, aerial drones provide elevated surveillance of the vessel, the dock, and the surrounding area simultaneously, closing the blind spots that ground-based security cannot address.

Proprietary Satellite Infrastructure

Andro Secure Group is currently deploying three proprietary satellites to orbit, delivering independent capabilities in secure communications, internet redundancy, and real-time site monitoring. This infrastructure eliminates dependency on commercial satellite networks that can be compromised, disrupted, or subjected to surveillance by hostile actors — providing clients with a communications backbone that remains operational regardless of the conditions facing commercial networks in the operational area.



Integrated Command & Control

The command-and-control architecture ties together autonomous drone boats, aerial surveillance drones, ground-based facility security, close protection teams, and cyber monitoring into a single coherent response framework. When any one layer of the system detects a threat, all other layers are simultaneously informed and coordinated. This eliminates the communication gaps that plague fragmented security arrangements and enables the Group to address coordinated attacks — such as simultaneous cyber intrusion and physical boarding — with a unified, multi-domain response.

IT Security & Cyber Protection

A vessel’s navigation system, cargo management platform, and communications network are only as secure as the IT infrastructure that supports them. Cyberattacks on maritime operators are increasing in frequency and sophistication: from ransomware that locks operational systems to GPS spoofing that can redirect a vessel off course. Andro Secure Group’s IT security and cyber protection services monitor, defend, and respond to digital threats across clients’ entire technology stacks.

The quality of a security operation is ultimately determined by the quality of the personnel executing it. Andro Secure Group’s personnel selection framework is one of the most rigorous in the industry — and the Group’s willingness to cover the cost of independent truth verification when the integrity of any personnel member is challenged is a commitment that speaks directly to the confidence placed in the selection process.

Personnel Selection Framework

All personnel are selected through a tested, multi-stage framework aligned to both company standards and statutory requirements. Truth verification tests are conducted by independent institutions on a regular basis. Polygraph testing is a standard component of the vetting process.

Specialist Personnel Capabilities

Beyond the standard security profile, Andro Secure Group deploys specialist personnel in roles that no conventional security provider can match:

- Medical Staff:** Qualified medical personnel — up to paramedic level — are embedded in operational teams across maritime, transport, and executive protection assignments. Medical emergency response and backup for vessels in remote or high-risk waters ensures crew welfare is protected where conventional evacuation is not immediately available.
- Firefighting-Trained Personnel:** Fire prevention and firefighting-trained staff are deployed across industrial and maritime assignments, with capability in Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) compliance and Safety, Health and Environment (SHE) legislation.
- Gemmologists & Metallurgists:** Qualified gemmologists and metallurgists accompany teams on all precious metal and gemstone transport assignments — a unique capability that eliminates the risk of substitution or misidentification throughout the chain of custody.



- **Intelligence & Surveillance Specialists:** Covert surveillance operatives, intelligence network analysts, and voice stress analysis specialists support complex threat assessment and intelligence-led operational planning.

Multilingual Operational Capability

Approximately 70% of the world's major languages are represented across Andro Secure Group's operational teams. This linguistic coverage is a material operational advantage in global deployments, enabling genuine client engagement, local intelligence gathering, and threat communication in the native language of the environments in which the Group operates.

Code of Conduct

All Andro Secure Group personnel operate under a formally documented Code of Conduct that governs professional conduct, client confidentiality, truthful reporting, legal compliance, and ethical practice. Key commitments include:

The Integrated Security Imperative

The security industry is undergoing a fundamental shift. Threats are no longer domain specific. A piracy operation at sea may be coordinated with a cyber intrusion that disables AIS tracking. An executive targeting event in a port city may be preceded by intelligence gathering conducted through compromised facility IT systems. Physical and digital attacks are converging, and security providers that address these threats in isolation are leaving their clients exposed.

Andro Secure Group's unified security ecosystem was designed for this reality. By integrating autonomous technology, intelligence-led operations, specialist personnel, and cyber monitoring into a single operational framework, the Group addresses the full attack surface — not just the visible physical component. This approach is not widely available in the security market; it requires proprietary technology, multi-domain expertise, and an operational architecture that most providers have neither the capability nor the infrastructure to build.

Autonomous Technology as the New Standard

The deployment of armed autonomous drone boats for maritime security represents a generational advance over conventional security models. Visible deterrence — the presence of autonomous systems that hostile actors can observe and cannot easily defeat — changes the risk calculus for attackers before an incident begins. This shifts the security model from response to prevention: not catching attackers after they have boarded but making the decision to attack economically and operationally irrational in the first place.

Andro Secure Group's proprietary satellite infrastructure further advances this position, providing independent communications and monitoring capability that cannot be disrupted by attacks on commercial networks. As maritime security threats increasingly target communications infrastructure, this capability will become an industry standard. Andro Secure Group is already there.

Social Responsibility & Employment Equity
